St Paul's Site Re-Development Plan



The St Paul's Church site on Whitley Wood Lane has been a spiritual and pastoral centre for the local community since 1911. It currently hosts a disabled day care group, the Play Barn (a soft play area for toddlers and their parents/carers), the St Paul's congregation and a Nigerian fellowship, as well as one-off events such as children's parties.

The vision is to realise the potential of the site to be a community hub that will bring well-being to the people of the neighbourhood.

New Church Centre and Health Centre:



The new multi-purpose Church Centre will have:

- Flexible, accessible and inclusive space for worship, social events and soft play
- Hall with independent facilities, suitable for potentially vulnerable groups such as nurseries and caring for those with addictions, disabilities or mental health problems
- Café
- Small meeting/office rooms
- Dedicated quiet chapel, open to all
- Two one-bedroom flats.

Our aim is to provide services that meet the priority 'well-being' needs of the local community. Over time these could include the provision of information, advice and support on a wide range of personal issues such as debt management, housing, relationship problems and bereavement.

Local Services for Local Needs



The new Health Centre facilities will include:

- Full GP and nursing services
- Minor operations
- Joint injections
- Patient Group Consultations
- Physiotherapy
- Counselling
- Out-patient type clinics
- Blood tests

This will reduce the need of the those living locally to attend the Royal Berks Hospital for these services.
